This month the rainbow room visited the toy museum! They got the train to Bethnal green and spent the day exploring the museum, they also had a picnic lunch!



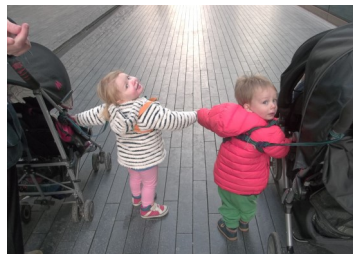
In honour of the queens 90th birthday, we decorated the nursery from top to bottom and spent the

We will be holding a fancy dress day at the nursery on: **Thursday 12th May**

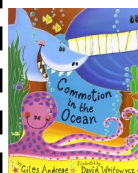
The theme for the day is superheroes and princesses! In aid of Crackerjacks children's Trust. There will be a bucket at reception for any donations towards the charity.

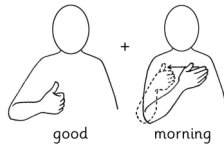
Best Practice at the Arc!
