
The theme in both the Sunshine & Rainbow Rooms next month will be Pirates & Under the Sea.



The Arc Buggy Cupboard Rules—

Sometimes it can be very difficult to access the cupboard, due to the

amount of buggies placed at the entrance and because of the size of some of the buggies being stored.

At the Arc we have limited storage space for buggies and as such we ask the following -

All children who are 3 years or older should be encouraged to walk, ride or scoot to and from the nursery in order to promote physical and social development.

All buggies stored are to be an umbrella type, which take up as little room as possible and fold completely. If you would prefer to use a larger buggy then please be aware that it will need to be taken away from the nursery with you once you have dropped off your child.

When storing buggies it is imperative that parents fill it from the back forwards, so that it is easily accessible for all. Also can parents please make sure that their buggy is empty so that it can collapse fully.

If there are no hooks left to hang a buggy up on, then all parents need to neatly place their buggies against the wall opposite or lean them in between the hooks. In order to leave a walk way throughout the cupboard to allow everyone to have easy access.

Please can all parents bear in mind that we do not have to allocate a space for buggy storage, and as such the limited space supplied needs to be used to maximum efficiency in order for it to be fairly allocated to all children throughout the nursery.
